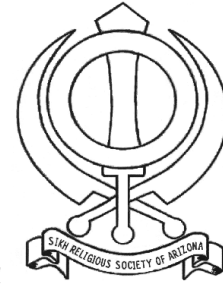


Waheguru Ji Ka Khalsa, Waheguru Ji Ki Fateh!

The most important announcement that we would like to make in this letter is that there will be a Vaisakhi congregation on Sunday, April 19, 1997 at the future site of "ARIZONA SIKH GURDWARA" at 38th Ave and Beardsley. Kirtan will be performed at the site. Last year's Vaisakhi was a big success. Please help us make this even a bigger success this year. Make every effort to attend. Bring your family and friends along.
